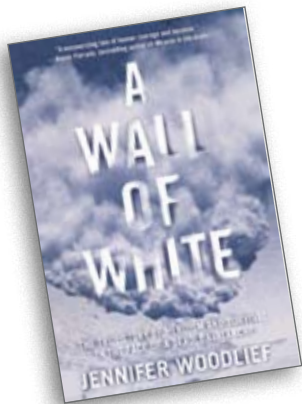

The true-story account of the '82 avalanche at Alpine Meadows, considered one of the worst ski resort avalanches in North American history, in which seven people were killed and a woman was found alive under the snow after five days, is currently being shopped around to movie studios, so read the book before the story hits the big screen.

FLIP THE SWITCH The future looks bright at San Domenico School, which has just unveiled its 412-kilowatt solar energy system. The solar project is expected to reduce carbon emissions by 860,000 pounds annually—equivalent to removing 70 vehicles from the road or preserving three acres of forest from deforestation. The 2,300 panels will offset nearly 85 percent of the school’s expected annual electricity costs. sandomenico.org
